






















































Instructions:

- 1. Fold page one on the first vertical dashed line.
- 2. Cut the horizontal dashed lines in boxes 1, 6, 11, 16 and 21.
- 3. Using the opening those cuts made, cut the vertical dashed line in each of the boxes (1, 6, 11, 16 and 21). Be careful not to cut the solid lines or anywhere outside of the boxes.
- 4. Repeat the previous steps for each column until openings are cut into each box.
- 5. Using glue or tape, secure page one above page two. If using glue, be careful to avoid glueing inside the boxes.
