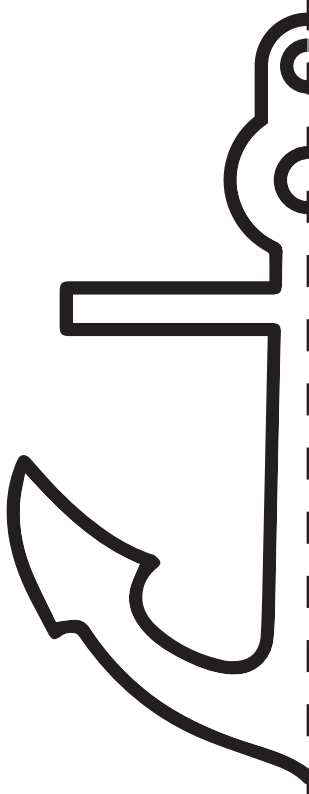


ADVENT CHRISMON ORNAMENTS

Instructions:

1. Fold papers in half on dashed line.
2. Cut ornaments on solid black lines.
2. Unfold.
3. Color and decorate ornaments as desired.
4. Punch hole and loop string or ribbon through the ornament.

The Anchor Cross reminds Christians that Jesus is the anchor of their faith.

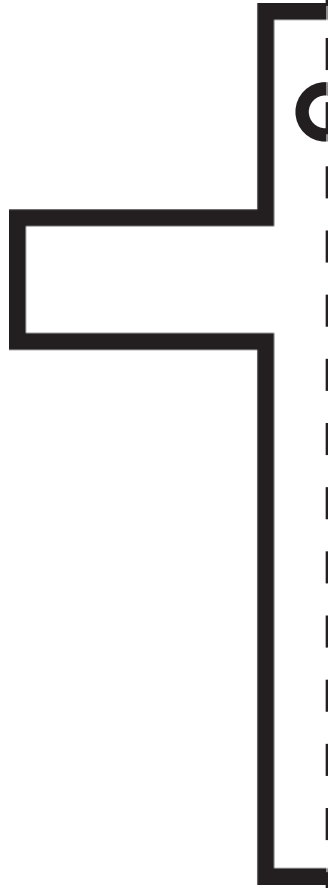


The Manger represents Jesus as a baby at Christmas.

The Cross symbolizes that Christians believe Jesus Christ died for everyone on a Cross.



The Star of David is a symbol that Jesus was a Jew and a descendant of King David.

The Candle represents the idea that Christians believe Jesus is the Light of the World.



The Cup is a symbol of the Mass, Eucharist or Communion. It represents God's forgiveness.

The Scroll represents the Bible.



The Fish is one of the oldest Christian symbols. The letters in the Greek word for fish stand for Jesus (I), Christ (X), God (Q), Son (Y), Savior (S).
