Amen! Isaiah 26:3: You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!

5. We will have all that we want.

No! God promises to provide all we need but not necessarily all we want. **Philippians 4:19**

6. We have forgiveness.

Amen! 1 John 1:9: But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.

7. We have salvation if we do enough good things.

No! We are saved by grace and faith in Jesus, not be works! **Ephesians 2:8**

8. Jesus is preparing a place for us **in** heaven.

Amen! John 14:2: There is more than enough room in my Father's home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?

9. The Holy Spirit only lives up in heaven.

No! The Holy Spirit lives inside us! **1 Corinthians 3:16**

10. He will never fail us or abandon us.

Amen! Deuteronomy 31:6: So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the LORD your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you."
