Large Group

1. Do you think God was concerned about His people when they were slaves in Egypt? Explain.

Small Group

1. What kind of work do you think the people of Israel were doing in Egypt?
2. Do you think that God knew what was going on—why or why not?
3. Who could they cry out to; could it be a normal man or woman? How about a Superhero?

1. What does oppression mean?
2. What is a taskmaster?
3. Who is saying the words in Exodus 3:7?
4. Have you ever had trouble hearing someone talk to you when there was a lot of noise?

SuperVerse

1. Open your Bibles to the book of Exodus. What do you think the word “exodus” means?
2. Why is Exodus a good name for this book?

Prayer

1. Why does it sometimes feel like we will be on Earth forever?
2. Compared to eternity, our life on Earth is extremely short, isn't it?

Additional Activities

Wilderness Game

1. Name some obstacles Moses faced after leaving Egypt.
2. What responsibilities do you think go with being a child of God?
3. How did it feel to trust a guide you could not see?
4. How did it feel to have the responsibility to be the guide?
5. How is it comforting to know God sees all you do and all of the problems you face each day?
6. Name a time that God answered a prayer you prayed.

Discussion activity

1. What kinds of jobs require a toolbox?
2. How did God equip Moses for the job of leading His people out of Egypt?
3. How does God equip us?

Object Lesson

1. Watch the rock very closely. (Wait several seconds.) Did the rock move for anyone?
