

Reveal Jesus Q & A

(Tell children that traits may be repeated in verses. After each question ask:)

What traits or character qualities do you think are revealed about Jesus in the Scriptures that I read?

1. Mark 8:1–3,6a (NKJV) *In those days, the multitude being very great and having nothing to eat, Jesus called His disciples to Him and said to them, “I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat.” So He commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground and He took the seven loaves and gave thanks. Compassion, thankful, prayerful,*
2. Mark 8:7–9 (NKJV) *He ... broke them and gave them to His disciples to set before them; and they set them before the multitude. They also had a few small fish; and having blessed them, He said to set them also before them. So they ate and were filled, and they took up seven large baskets of leftover fragments. Now those who had eaten were about four thousand. And He sent them away. Servant (gave them bread), Miracle worker, provider.*
3. Now, I have an easy but very important one for you! Everyone needs to know this! 1 John 4:19 *We love each other because He loved us first. Loves us, came to us—unconditional, love.*
4. John 14:1 *“Don’t let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in Me.” Trustworthy, gives peace, comforts, caring, faithful (like God), points to God.*
5. John 14:2–4 *“There is more than enough room in My Father’s home. If this were not so, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with Me where I am. And you know the way to where I am going.” Knowledge and wisdom (knows heaven and future, works on our behalf, does not lie - tells truth, faithful to return, keeps promises, teacher, way, eternal.*
6. John 14:6 *Jesus told him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through Me.” Way (to God, heaven), truth, life (eternal, spiritual).*
7. John 14:27 *“I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don’t be troubled or afraid.” Gives, blesses, equips, source of peace, supernatural, takes away fear, anxiety.*
8. Mark 2:17 *When Jesus heard this, he told them, “Healthy people don’t need a doctor—sick people do. I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners.” Hears, listens, knows condition of individuals, had a mission, does not like pride, self-righteous, came to save, can forgive sins, came for helpless.*
9. John 1:29 *The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!” Jesus comes to people, Lamb of God, sent by God, sinless, spotless, innocent, takes away, forgives sin, satisfies God’s judgment, makes us righteous.*
10. Luke 18:16 *Then Jesus called for the children and said to the disciples, “Let the children come to Me. Don’t stop them! For the Kingdom of God belongs to those who are like these children.” Jesus has authority, loves children, sees faith as innocence.*
