NARRATOR SCRIPT

Choose volunteer actors to be Peter, Rhoda, Mary, and two actors to pray. You may also have three other actors to be the angel and two prison guards. Pause after reading each line so the actors repeat their lines or act out their parts. Feel free to improvise as you go along. Peter should begin the skit in "prison" at one end of the room. The prayer group (Rhoda, Mary, and the two other actors) should kneel in another corner of the room.

Narrator

Peter was in prison.

An angel of the Lord appeared in a bright light and supernaturally freed Peter from the chains and his cell. The angel led Peter past the guards to the gate at the entrance of the prison. How did the gate open; did the angel have a key? The door swung open by itself, and Peter and the angel walked into the street.

Peter pinched himself and said, "This isn't a vision, this is real!"
