Teaching

1. What does "humble" mean?
2. What does "proud" mean?

Read the following statements; vote and discuss whether the person was humble or proud.

3. John and his brother want to have places of honor when Jesus becomes King. (Proud.)
4. Jesus said the Son of Man came to serve—not to be served. (Humble.)
5. Jesus rides a donkey instead of a stallion. (Humble.)
6. The religious leaders tell Jesus to quiet the crowd. (Proud.)
7. A woman uses her hair and expensive perfume to anoint Jesus' feet. (Humble.)
8. Judas is angry with the woman for using the expensive perfume to anoint Jesus. (Proud.)
9. Jesus washes the disciples' feet. (Humble.)
10. Peter refuses to let Jesus wash his feet. (Proud.)
11. Judas betrays Jesus for 30 pieces of silver. (Proud.)
12. Jesus turned over the money changer's tables in the temple. (Humble.)

1. What do you think it means to be chosen by God?
2. What responsibility do we have to God?
3. What do you think it means to make allowance for others?
4. Why should we forgive someone who sins against us?
5. What does the verse mean by clothing ourselves?
6. How do you want to be treated by others when you stumble or make a mistake?

Romans 12:10

1. Is love just a warm feeling we have on the inside, or is it a decision that we show by our actions and words? Give some examples?
2. What do you think it means when it says, “genuine affection”?
3. What does it mean to honor someone?
4. Have you ever honored someone more than yourself?

1. What does it mean to submit to someone?
2. What should be our motivation for this?
