### **Large Group**

1. What can happen if you try to walk in dark room, or outside at night without any light?

### **Game**

1. What did the man said when Jesus asked, "Can you see anything now?"
2. Who is the light of the world today?
3. How do we let our lights shine?

### **Teaching**

#### **Signpost #1**

1. Jesus asked His disciples, "Who do people say I am?" What did they answer?
2. When He asked Peter, "But who do you say I am", what did Peter reply?

#### **Discipleship Challenge**

1. Last time, our challenge was to seek after things above—God's things—instead of the things of this world. Did you find that easy or hard, and why?

### **Prayer**

1. Jesus said that whoever followed Him would have the light of life (John 8:12). Should we keep that light hidden, like a secret?

### **Additional Activities**

#### **Object Lesson**

1. Should a follower of Christ keep these things in their heart? Why not?

#### **Craft Activity**

1. Imagine yourselves as you walked to the pool of Siloam to wash the mud from your eyes. What would your thoughts be?
2. What do you think it would feel like to suddenly be able to see everything around you after being in darkness?
3. In our Bible story, what were the three ways that Jesus healed the eyes of the men who were blind?
4. There is no right or wrong answer to this question; why do you think Jesus used different methods to heal the blind men?
5. What do you think people's reactions might have been to see Jesus spit on one man's eyes and then to rub mud in another's eyes?
