

EMPTY TOILET PAPER TUBE

... or cut a paper towel tube into a 3-inch tube.



This is a reflective paper; it looks like a mirror. You can find single sheets in the scrapbook section of craft stores. The sheets are 12x12 and can be used to make 4 kaleidoscopes.




TAPE

Glue could work too.

SCISSORS

Use safety scissors if available.




DIRECTIONS

STEP1

Decorate the toilet-paper tube with paint, markers, or crayons.


STEP 2

Cut the Mylar paper into 4 parts and fold it into a triangular prism. Then place the prism into the tube — with the shiny side facing in. Cut off any excess tube or mylar that remains.



STEP 3

Look through one end of the tube. Isn't that cool? Turn the tube while looking to mix things up!



You've just made a Kaleidoscope! That's a device that allows you to see things from a different perspective. Light reflects off of the "mirrors" to shift your vision.
