Lesson 1

Seek God's face.

Read 1 Chronicles 16:11–12 (NLT): Search for the LORD and for His strength; continually seek Him. Remember the wonders He has performed, His miracles, and the rulings He has given.

Lesson 2

Seek what God desires.

Read Psalm 37:4–5 (NLT): Take delight in the LORD, and He will give you your heart's desires. Commit everything you do to the LORD. Trust Him, and He will help you.

1. What does it mean to delight in the Lord?
2. When we delight in Him and in His ways, what things should we desire?

Lesson 3

Seek to expand His kingdom.

Read Isaiah 55:6–7 (NLT): Seek the LORD while you can find Him. Call on Him now while He is near. Let the wicked change their ways and banish the very thought of doing wrong. Let them turn to the LORD that He may have mercy on them. Yes, turn to our God, for He will forgive generously.

1. Why is it important to pray for people to seek the Lord and turn to Him?
2. What happens when people seek God and turn to Him?
