

## Discussion Questions Course 113–3

### Large Group

1. Have you ever prepared for an important event in the future? What was it?
2. Who remembers what happened when Chris disobeyed his father's rules?
3. Have you ever looked forward to seeing someone you haven't seen for a long time?
4. It is hard to wait, isn't it? Would it be easier to wait if you knew they were bringing a gift for you with them?

### Small Group

#### Game

1. Someday, when we go to heaven, what kinds of things can we bring with us—can we bring a house, or a car, or a bicycle?
2. But there is something we CAN bring. Can you guess what it is?
3. Our SuperTruth says: "I will prepare others for the coming of the Lord." How can we do that?

### Teaching

1. What does the balloon falling from the sky represent?

#### *Signpost #1*

1. Additional discussion for Grades 1–6: read Romans 8:35–37, then discuss how we can have peace and confidence.

#### *Signpost #2*

1. Additional discussion for Grades 1–6: read Daniel 12:1–3 and discuss how it feels to know that any work you do for God now will not be forgotten.
2. Read Zechariah 12:10 and discuss how God shows His love and patience.

#### *Signpost #3*

1. Read Isaiah 65:25 and discuss the authority and power of God's Word.
2. Read Zephaniah 3:14–15 and discuss how it would feel to have no troubles or fears.

#### *Signpost #4*

1. Additional discussion for Grades 1–6: read Mark 14:61–62, then discuss what it means to have the power of Jesus through the Holy Spirit available to you now.

### Discipleship Challenge

1. How many were able to learn all of the verses?
2. Did you share God's Plan with anyone, and what happened?

### SuperVerse

1. Jesus is coming again and He has promised rewards for us according to our work. What kind of work do you think He is talking about?
2. This joy and crown is Paul's reward. And what is his joy and crown?

### Prayer

1. Does anyone know what an ambassador is?

### **Object Lesson**
