

Revelation: The Final Battle: Lesson 3

SuperTruth: I will prepare others for the coming of the Lord.

SuperVerse: “And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work.” Revelation 22:12 (NKJV)

Bible Story: Acts 1:9–11; Revelation 1; 16:16; 19:11–21; 20:7–10; 21; 22

Game Materials Needed:

- Paper—at least 5 sheets per child, plus about 25 extra sheets
- Pencils—one per child plus extras
- Laundry basket or medium size box
- Timer—stopwatch, clock or watch with second hand, or timer app
- Bible or the Superbook Bible App

Teaching Materials Needed:

- God’s Plan Revealed Craft for children who missed Lessons 1 and 2
- Signpost Pattern
- Fulfillment Slip Pattern
- One pair of children’s scissors
- Four balloons, not blown up, plus extras
- String, yarn or ribbon
- Optional: tape

LARGE GROUP / GRADES 1–6

This is the final lesson of the Superbook adventure called “Revelation.” Jesus is coming back again! We need to prepare ourselves—and tell everyone we can and prepare others, too!

- Be sure to preview the condensed Bible story video, as it contains intense imagery that may be disturbing for some children.
- In the Signposts video we will learn more about the prophecies that will be fulfilled when Jesus comes again!

SMALL GROUP / GRADES 1–6

Game: What Can We Bring? (15 minutes)

Objective: Explore the Superbook story by playing a game about bringing others to heaven.

- When we go to heaven someday, we can’t bring a house, or a car, or a bicycle. We can’t bring any “thing.” But there is something we CAN bring—other people! That’s what this game is about.

Game Instructions:

- Pairs of children will have 10 seconds—add time for younger children or those with special needs—to bring as many balls as possible to the basket/box that represents heaven. Count the balls after each turn and see which team can bring the most to heaven!

Teaching: Jesus Fulfills Everything (15 minutes)

Objective: Discuss prophecies Jesus will fulfill at His second coming.

- Inside each balloon is a prophecy Jesus will fulfill by returning to Earth. Children will pop the balloons and then learn how Jesus fulfills each one.

Take Home Activity—Discipleship Challenge (2 minutes)

- The challenge is to continue learning all the verses. Then pray for God to show you how to share His plan with your friends!

SuperVerse: Superbook Shout (5 minutes)

Objective: Memorize the SuperVerse with a group activity.

- Jesus is coming again and He has promised rewards for us according to our work. Our greatest reward is to know that we have shared the Gospel with others and to watch them live for God.
- Divide the children into three groups and assign each group one-third of the SuperVerse. Give them a minute or two to memorize their part of the SuperVerse and the scripture reference. Have the groups stand in one line in the correct order of the verse. Have each group shout their part aloud—one after the other, and then all will shout the scripture reference together.

Prayer: Preparation Prayers (5 minutes)

Objective: Communicate with God.

- We are Jesus’ voice to prepare people and to share the Gospel until He comes again! We are His hands to help people and show His love until He returns to Earth. We have a wonderful privilege to speak His message and help others come to the Lord!
- Have children find a place to be alone with God and pray for the people whose names they wrote down in an earlier game. Ask God to give you the boldness and opportunity to show His love to them so they can be prepared for His return!
