### **Large Group**

### **Small Group**

#### **Game**

2. What command did Jesus give His disciples?
3. What promise did Jesus give His disciples?
4. Who can tell me what the Good News is?
5. Why do you think we placed you in four corners of the room?

#### **Teaching**

2. What are we supposed to do with the Good News—is it an important secret we must keep?

##### **Luke 24:38–40**

1. Jesus was mocked and ridiculed by the angry mob and crowds on His way to the cross and as He was crucified. How do you think He endured this?
2. What do you think was going through the disciples' minds at this point?
3. Would it be difficult to see the wounds and know what Jesus had endured for you?

##### **Matthew 27:35**

1. Isn't it amazing, all the details that had been prophesied and then fulfilled by Jesus?
2. What does this say about God and His plan and His Word?
3. What did the soldiers do in this verse?
4. Why do you think they would want to keep His clothes?
