Bible Study Luke 22:31–32

Verse 31

- 2. What do you think it means to "sift as wheat"?
- 3. What do you think is significant about Satan's request in Verse 31?
- 4. How do you think this verse applies to us today?
- 5. How do you think we can prepare ourselves against what Satan tries to do today?

Verse 32

- 1. How did Jesus help Peter, even before the test?
- 2. Why do you think God would allow us to be tested or tried at all?
- 3. In verse 32, it is interesting to note that the word "you" this time is singular—Jesus prayed specifically for Peter to be strengthened. How could be strengthen the other disciples?
- 4. What is the significance of Jesus saying, "When you have repented and turned to Me again"?
