

“Turn to Jesus” Sheet

1. Peter’s mother-in-law had a fever. What could she do? [Turn to Jesus!](#) Jesus rebuked the fever and it instantly left her! She got up and fixed the disciples a meal! [\(Luke 4:38–39\)](#)
2. A man in the crowd that followed Jesus had leprosy. What could he do? [Turn to Jesus!](#) Jesus touched him and the man was instantly healed! [\(Matthew 8:1–4\)](#)
3. A woman suffered from constant bleeding for 12 years. What could she do? [Turn to Jesus!](#) Jesus turned and said: “Your faith has made you well.” And the woman was healed at that moment. [\(Matthew 9:20–22\)](#)
4. A man at the temple had a deformed hand. Who could he turn to for healing? [Turn to Jesus!](#) Jesus said, “Hold out your hand.” So the man held out his hand, and it was restored, just like the other one! [\(Matthew 12:9–14\)](#)
5. A crowd of over 5,000 people followed Jesus and got very hungry. They had no food. The disciples did not know what to do. What could they do? [Turn to Jesus!](#) Jesus took five loaves of bread and two fish from a boy and prayed to God. There was enough food to feed the crowd with twelve baskets of food left over! [\(Matthew 14:13–21\)](#)
6. The tax man asked Peter if Jesus and His disciples paid taxes. Peter did not have any money. What could He do? [Turn to Jesus!](#) Jesus told Peter to go fishing and open the mouth of the first fish he caught, and he would find a large silver coin to take and pay the tax! [\(Matthew 17:24–27\)](#)
7. A leader of the synagogue had a daughter who was sick and died. What could the father do now? [Turn to Jesus.](#) Jesus went to the girl’s bedside, took her by the hand, and she stood up! She was alive again! [\(Matthew 9:18,23–26\)](#)
