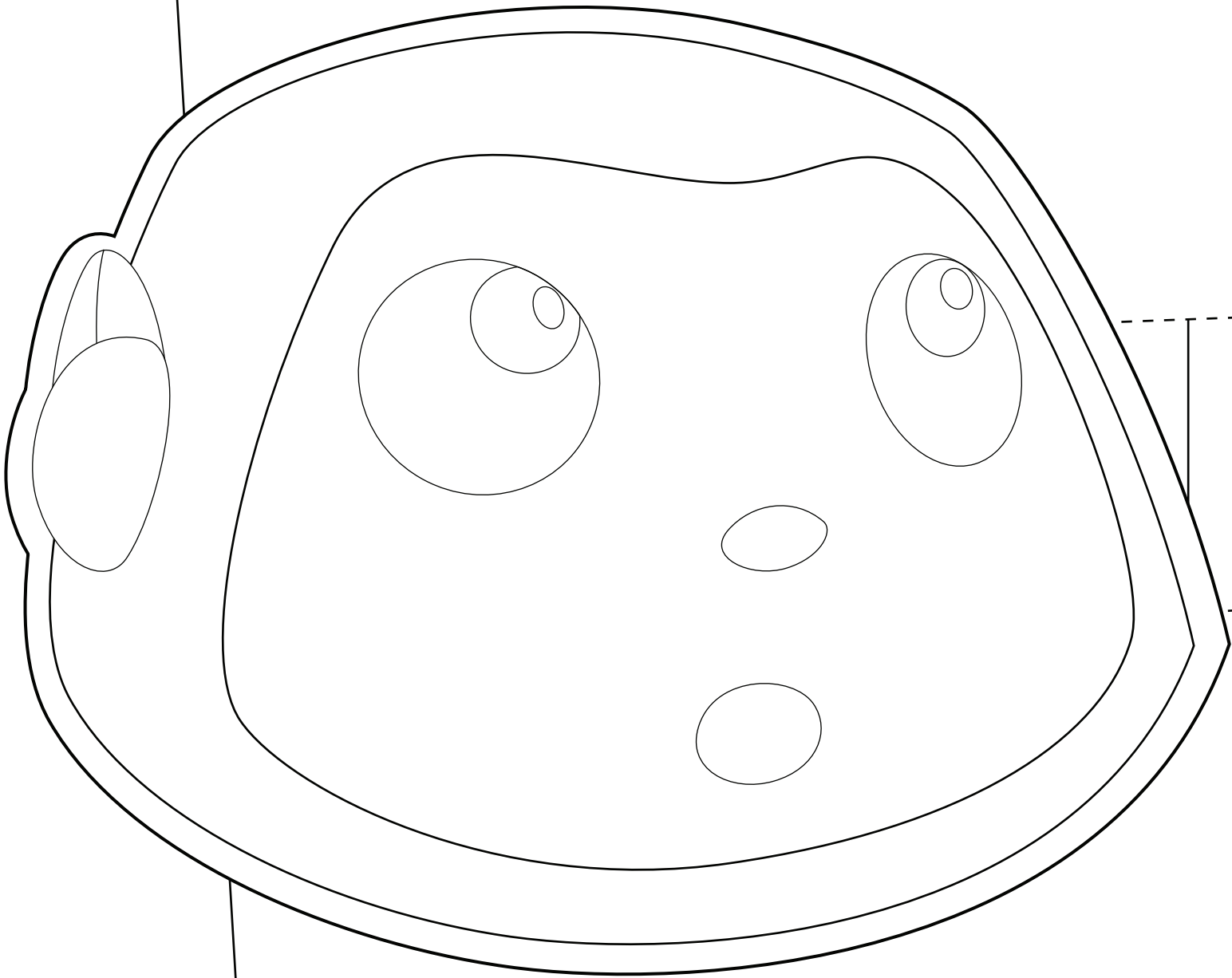
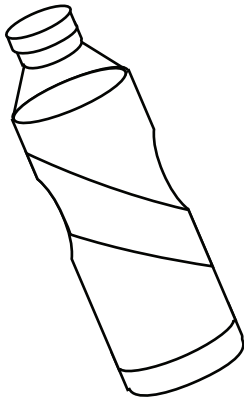

STEM ACTIVITY

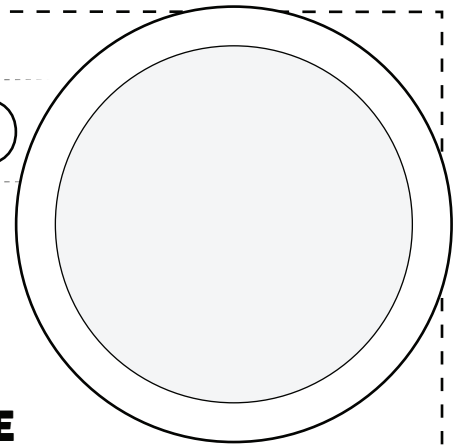
WHAT YOU NEED



WATER

At room temperature.

WHITE CERAMIC PLATE



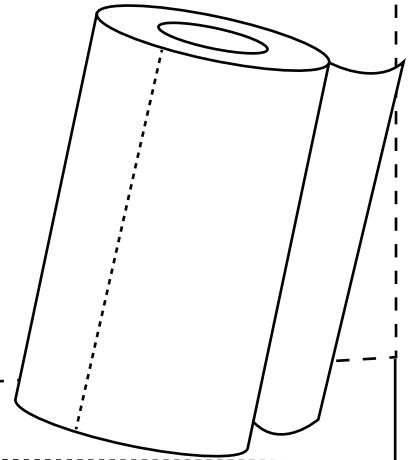
BLACK DRY ERASE MARKER

Expo markers work best.



PAPER TOWELS

For cleanup.



DIRECTIONS

STEP 1

Draw on the plate with the dry erase marker. You can draw anything you'd like, but the simpler the image, the easier it is to get it to float.

STEP 2

Slowly pour water from beside the drawing. Pouring too quickly may cause the drawing to be torn apart.

STEP 3

Watch as your drawing comes to life! Dry the plate. Repeat the process if you have time.

STICKY BUSINESS

Dry erase marker are not designed to adhere tightly to a surface like pens or permanent markers. As the water moves across the plate, it sneaks up under your drawing and lifts them to the surface of the water.
