

## **Discussion Questions Course 310–3**

### **Large Group**

1. If you were here for one of the previous lessons, why were Mary and Martha weeping?
2. What did they believe would have changed if Jesus had been with Lazarus before that happened?
3. Who created the world?
4. Who is God's Son?
5. What kind of life is the SuperVerse talking about?

### **Small Group**

#### **Game**

1. How many days had Lazarus been in the tomb when Jesus arrived?
2. What do you think Jesus' disciples thought at this point?
3. Lazarus had died and was in the tomb, yet that was about to change. What did Jesus tell the people to do with the tombstone?
4. What did Jesus do next?
5. What happened then?

#### **Teaching**

##### **Signpost #1**

1. Do you think Judas really cared about poor people?

##### **Signpost #2**

1. Who are Jesus' sheep?

##### **Signpost #3**

1. After Jesus died on the cross, He was wrapped in grave clothes and put into in a tomb. Then what happened?
2. By doing this, Jesus conquered sin and death forever, for everyone who believes in Him. When Jesus told Martha that He was the resurrection and the life, He asked her if she believed. Now, He asks us the same question: do you believe?

##### **Discipleship Challenge**

1. Why shouldn't we copy the behavior of others around us?
2. How can wrong thinking slow our spiritual growth?
3. How does thinking like God help us?
4. Were you able to pray and identify wrong thinking that could be harmful?
5. If you don't eat for many days at a time, what will happen to your body?

#### **Prayer**

1. Jesus said that the sickness wouldn't end in death. Jesus then stated the purpose for the sickness. What did Jesus say?
2. Did Jesus need to pray out loud so He was sure God could hear Him?
3. Jesus knew that God hears every prayer—even silent prayers. So why did He pray out loud?

#### **Additional Activities**

##### **Coloring Activity**

1. According to the SuperVerse, when we have God's Son, what do we have?
2. In the picture you are coloring, what are the two men doing for Lazarus?
3. If you were Lazarus, how do you think it would feel to be alive again?
4. Was everyone happy to witness Jesus' amazing miracle?
5. When Jesus died on the cross, did He stay dead?
