Nicodemus: Lesson 3

SuperTruth: God's Spirit is alive in me.

SuperVerse: *"And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you."* Ezekiel 36:26a (NLT)

Bible Story: Luke 13:10–17;14:1–6; John 3:1–16;7:50–52;19:39–40

LARGE GROUP / GRADES 1-6

As Jesus explained to Nicodemus, when we believe in Jesus, we receive eternal life and the Holy Spirit gives us a new life in Christ.

- Superbook takes Chris, Joy and Gizmo to Jerusalem, where Nicodemus, a Jewish religious leader, secretly meets with Jesus. The children learn that everyone must be born again to see the kingdom of God.
- Let's watch the Signposts video to learn about a spiritual birth that we all can experience and receive salvation through Jesus.

SMALL GROUP / GRADES 1-6

Game: Gone With the Wind (15 minutes)

Objective: Play a game to move balls with air.

• Jesus told Nicodemus that the wind blows wherever it wants, and you can't tell where it comes from. That is what this game is about: the invisible wind!

Game Instructions:

• The object of the game is to move a ball from one end of the table to the other end and into the box. The catch is that only the wind can move the ball!

Teaching: No Ordinary Man (15 minutes)

Objective: Jesus came to save us.

• The Pharisees were not impressed with Jesus' physical appearance. They believed He was just an ordinary man. Jesus quickly showed otherwise by healing a man before their very eyes.

Take Home Activity—Discipleship Challenge (2 minutes)

• The craft is the Jesus Reveals Truth Page. The challenge is found in Window #3.

SuperVerse: Superbook Inside Giving (5 minutes)

Objective: Memorize the SuperVerse with a group activity.

- God places His Spirit inside everyone who believes in Jesus. His Spirit enables us to walk in His way and do His will. What we need to do then is listen and follow His leading.
- Divide the verse into five parts and write it on the board. The girls say lines 1 and 3. The boys say lines 2 and 4 and all say line 5 together. Then, turn backs to the board and say it from memory.

Prayer: Living Prayers (5 minutes)

Objective: Communicate with God.

- God's Spirit is alive in us. He will guide us into God's truth, so we can live in a way that pleases God. However, God has given us a free will. He will not force us to follow His direction.
- Let's bow our heads and close our eyes. Let's pray silently and commit to following the Holy Spirit's leading. That means when He speaks to your heart, you will choose to follow.
