1. Were the disciples happy to find Jesus talking with the Samaritan woman?
2. Do you think Jesus was happy with His disciples' attitude?
3. In verses 28–29, what was the woman's response to her time with Jesus?
4. In verse 40, what did the people in the village do?
5. What did Jesus do?
6. Looking at verses 40–41, what do you think Jesus did during that time? Did He relax and take a short vacation?
7. Do you see any similarity between what the woman did and today's SuperTruth?
8. In verse 42, did the people just believe because of the woman's testimony?
9. Who did the people say they knew Jesus was—an amazing prophet and teacher?
10. The woman ran and couldn't wait to share about her encounter with Jesus. Because of her witness, many people became believers. What does this say about the excuse that we can't witness because we don't have all of the answers or we don't know the right words to say?

Matthew 9:36–38

1. According to verse 36, was Jesus annoyed with the large crowds?
2. What were the crowds compared to?
3. Can you think of a name Jesus called Himself that relates to verse 36?
4. How does having a shepherd benefit the people (sheep)?
5. How does this make you feel about submitting your life to Jesus as Lord and following Him as His disciple?
6. According to verse 37, what does Jesus mean by the harvest—is it some kind of food?
7. What can workers do to help bring in or gather the harvest?
8. Besides our part in sharing the Gospel, what does Jesus ask us to do?
9. In verse 38, Jesus mentions fields. Where do you think the fields are located?
