What is a birthright, and why did Jacob want it? What do you think Esau was thinking when he sold his birthright for a bowl of stew? What is the most precious possession you own, and would you trade it for a sandwich—even if you were really hungry at the moment?

Jesus talks about storing up our treasures in heaven. **Read Luke 12:34.** What does this mean to you?

PRAY Lord Jesus, when I get angry at someone, help me remember that people are more important than things— and that Your blessings are more valuable than any earthly treasure. Amen.



HURT FEELINGS


We all may feel hurt, angry or jealous sometimes—but what can happen if we stay that way? **Read Ephesians 4:26-27.** What do you think this means?

Isaac and Rebekah each had a favorite son. Who favored Esau and who favored Jacob?

How do you think this made the twins feel when they were growing up together? **Galatians 2:6** tells us that God has no favorites. What does this mean, and how does it make you feel?

People in the Bible were not perfect, and God's Word tells the truth about things they did. How did Jacob lie and steal to get Esau's blessing? **See Genesis 27:18-27.** If you were Esau, what would you want to do?

PRAY Heavenly Father, I thank You for loving me—and every person in the world—so very much. Help me share Your great love with others. Amen.

Joy not only told Chris she was sorry, she also asked him to forgive her. What's the difference, and why is it important? Do you need to ask anyone for forgiveness?

How did Jacob show Esau he was sorry? See Genesis 33:3.


Have people ever hurt you so badly that you thought you couldn't forgive them? **Read Ephesians 4:31-32**.
