THE CHOICE

Joseph went through some incredibly hard times! Can you name two things that happened to him that were not fair? What would you want to do if your family sold you as a slave, then you were put in prison for a crime that you didn't commit? [Read 1 Peter 3:9.](#)

Do you think Joseph was ever tempted to give up or get mad? How did he choose to act? [Read Matthew 5:43-45.](#) What are some ways you can show kindness to people who are mean to you?

Joseph served God faithfully even while he was a slave and in prison. Why do you think people trusted him so much?

PRAY Dear God, I praise You for being with me all the time, no matter what happens. Help me choose to serve You and love others even in tough times. Amen.



THE PURPOSE

When Pharaoh asked what his dreams meant, did Joseph take credit for the answer? **Read Genesis 41:15-16.**

What is a famine? How did Joseph treat his brothers when they finally recognized him? **Read Genesis 45:4-7.**

Jacob, who is also called Israel, was the son of Isaac and grandson of Abraham. Joseph and his brothers became the 12 tribes of Israel—God's chosen people. When Joseph was in the pit, do you think he realized this was part of God's plan to help his family? **Read Isaiah 55:8-9.**

Can you think of anything that God cannot control?
Read Romans 8:28.

PRAY Lord Jesus, thank You for working everything together for our good when we trust in You. Amen.
