When Moses doubted his own abilities, what helper did God give him? **Read Exodus 4:10-16.**

How do we gain confidence when we think we are not up to the challenge? **Read Philippians 4:13.**

PRAY Dear Lord, help me hear Your voice speak to my heart as I read Your Word and pray—and give me Your strength to obey everything You call me to do. Amen.



PROTECTION

How did God protect the Israelites when the firstborn sons of Egypt died? **Read Exodus 12:12-13**.

Today, God still saves everyone who trusts in the blood of the Lamb. Who is the Lamb of God? **Read John 1:29**.

How did Jesus take away the sins of the world? **Read 1 Peter 1:18-22.**

The Lamb of God is also our Good Shepherd! What has He done for us? **Read John 10:14-15.**

How did Moses' training as a shepherd prepare him to lead the Israelites in the wilderness?

What are some things that a loving shepherd must do? **Read Psalm 23**.

PRAY Dear Jesus, thank You for shedding Your precious blood on the cross to save me from my sins. I trust You as my Savior, my Shepherd, and my Lord. Amen.

Courage is not the absence of fear—courage is doing the right thing even though we may feel afraid. How can we choose to be bold instead of fearful? **Read Hebrews 13:5-6.**

What two things did Moses tell them to do? **Read Exodus 14:13-14.**


How did God deliver His people, and how did they respond? **Read Exodus 14:29-31.**
