What promise does God give His people if they humbly pray and confess their sins? **Read 2 Chronicles 7:14**.

How did God use the king of Persia to help answer Nehemiah's prayer? **Read Nehemiah 2:1-6**.

PRAY Heavenly Father, we praise You that we can come to You for all of our needs. Help us wait patiently for Your answers. In Jesus' name, amen.



COURAGE

When Nehemiah encouraged the Jewish leaders to rebuild Jerusalem's walls and gates, how did they respond? **Read Nehemiah 2:16-18.**

What did Nehemiah do when his enemies mocked him and plotted to hurt him? **Read Nehemiah 4:1-4; 6:9.**

Does everything always go smoothly when we obey God? **Read John 16:33**.

What should we remember if things seem to go wrong? **Read Matthew 14:27**.

What did Nehemiah tell the people would be their strength? **Read Nehemiah 8:10**.

PRAY Dear God, help us trust in You whenever we face difficult times. Please fill us Your joy, which is our strength!

COMMITMENT




Many years after Nehemiah lived, another man in the Bible was cruelly mocked. Can you guess His name? Read John 19:1-3 and Matthew 27:37-44.
