THE PREPARATION

How did God prepare Joseph for what he should do? **Read Matthew 1:18-21.** Do you think it was easy or hard for Mary and Joseph to obey God, and why?

How did God make it possible for Mary and Joseph, who were from Nazareth, to be so far away in Bethlehem for Jesus' birth? **Read Luke 2:1-5**.

PRAY Dear God, please help me understand the real meaning of Christmas and to share the Good News of Jesus with others. Amen.

What wonderful gift has God given us? Read John 3:16.


Do we have to earn or pay for this wonderful gift from God? **Read Ephesians 2:8-9**.
