Can you name three ways that Paul's life was saved in this story? [Read Acts 27:42-44](#) and [Acts 28:3-5.](#)

God preserved Paul from being killed by a Roman soldier, from drowning, and from a deadly snakebite!

Did you know that God is watching over you, too?
[Read Psalm 139:8-10.](#)

PRAY I praise You, Lord God, that You are watching over me day and night, wherever I may go. Help me to have faith in You during the storms of life. Amen.



THE MISSION

Paul was on a special mission from God. Do you know what it was? **Read Acts 23:11.**

As Paul obeyed God and preached the Gospel, he experienced many hardships. Do you think he always felt bold and confident and strong? No, Paul felt weak sometimes, but he wasn't ashamed—in fact, he bragged about it! Can you guess why? **Read 2 Corinthians 12:9-10.**

In one of Paul's letters to followers of Jesus, he shared an important key to finding strength and peace in the midst of hard times. Can you guess what it is? **Read Philippians 4:6-7.**

The Roman soldiers wore very strong armor—but did you know Paul wrote about an even stronger kind of armor that Christians should wear? **Read Ephesians 6:14-20.**

PRAY Heavenly Father, remind me to pray when I feel weak and to stand strong in Your power. Please give me Your strength to share the Good News about Jesus Christ with others. Amen.
